To date, we have generated enough profits to help 10 young people exit homelessness - our partners at Launch Housing are currently finding accommodation for the young people we assist. We also run our own Hospitality Training Program that gives paid training opportunities to young people, assisting them to find employment pathways and to independently exit the homelessness cycle.
